

Multi-Casualty Incident (MCI) Training: Basic Operations 2/16 & 3/16, 2011 Weaverville



COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The **Basic Operations** course is suitable for EMS, fire rescue, and receiving facility personnel who might have to contribute to the successful handling of a MCI and its patients. These incidents include multi-vehicle crashes and other events generating patient numbers that stress the local EMS system. Students will learn:

- How MCI operations differ from routine & disaster response
- Multi-casualty patient triage
- Terms & roles common to MCI operations
- Duties & responsibilities
- Basic MCI scene and response organization
- How to prioritize and organize multi-casualty patient transportation
- Receiving facility considerations
- Common errors in MCI operations

This is a prerequisite for the **MCI Advanced Management** course coming later this spring.
